What is Heart Resonance?

As an outreach of First United Methodist Church, **Deborah Marshall, CM-Th** provides a gentle cradle of sound to help support individuals in times of physical, emotional and spiritual stress, using harp and voice.

Who might benefit?

Services are available to those in physical or emotional need in various settings: at home, senior residences, in a hospital room, clinic or crisis shelter. People in crisis benefit from the comfort of this individualized care, human presence and music. These might include the family members of a critically ill person, the recently bereaved and anyone suffering from a physical or emotional crisis. Vigils at the bedside of the dying using prescriptive music also are a part of this ministry.

What to expect during a visit

Quiet prescriptive music is carefully selected for the moment. No verbal response is needed; simply receive. Periods of silence are interspersed with the music and an average visit is 30 to 60 minutes. Provided by a certified, professional music thanatologist, there is no cost for this ministry. Practitioners are committed to fostering trust, insuring confidentiality, respectfulness and sensitivity. Background check certified. To make an appointment call the church office at 541.345.8764.
